



Odorless Nail Enhancement System Instructions

For Professional Use Only

Spa Liquid is a superior odorless sculpting monomer that delivers beautiful long lasting enhancements without the scent of traditional EMA liquids. Spa Liquid has a higher molecular weight which makes it heavier and thicker. Using Spa Liquid requires a drier mix ratio than traditional monomers. It has unique working properties and is non-evaporating and non-volatile.

For the best results, use with NSI Attraction or Classic Nail Powders. It is the perfect enhancement addition for spas, salons, schools, and state board testing.

Natural Nail Prep

Proper preparation of the natural nail and workstation are preventative steps to guard against problems and will help you get the best possible results from your professional nail service.

1. Spray your hands and clients hands with Sani-Pure and gently massage. Sani-Pure will help reduce the spread of infection.
2. Apply a very small drop of NSI's Vanish cuticle dissolve to each cuticle and gently massage. Gently push back the eponychium, and remove any non-living tissue. Wipe excess Vanish from each nail, using a Nail Wipe moistened with NSI Cleanse.
3. Remove the shine from the natural nail using NSI Prep 180 grit file following the contour of the nail and moving the file in the direction of nail plate growth.
4. Remove excess dust with the NSI Plush Brush.
5. Using an NSI Nail Wipe saturated with Nailpure Plus, press and rub into natural nail, sidewalls, and under free edge to remove oil, moisture, and contaminants. Nailpure Plus leaves behind microbial agents to aid in the prevention of infection long after the enhancement service. Allow natural nail to become chalky white.
6. If extensions are desired, adhere tip or fit form at this time.
7. Apply Attract Acid-Free Primer liberally to the natural nails. Remove the brush from the bottle and wipe along the edge of the bottle, then brush onto two natural nails. Re-dip the brush and repeat the process until the nails are coated. Allow to dry for one minute. They will not appear chalky white.

Mix Ratio

Spa Liquid requires a medium dry mix ratio; approx. 1 to 1

1. Submerge brush completely into dappen dish of monomer (Spa Liquid will feel slightly thicker than traditional monomers) and flatten hairs to saturate brush. This will force out any oxygen trapped around the brush hairs. Complete saturation is recommended at the beginning of each service.
2. Wipe the brush along the sides of the dappen dish several times to release excess liquid. The more liquid you remove the smaller the bead pick up. Leave larger amounts of liquids for larger beads that may be required.
3. Dip the flags (the very tip of the brush) into the powder, hold and press until desired bead size has been achieved. Remove the brush from the powder and check the bead. Gently press the brush back into the powder, for additional powder pick up. The bead should be medium dry and there might be dry powder still visible. This is fine, because once you place the bead on the nail, it will become creamy. When the bead is placed on the nail, it should level about 25% and when it is pressed, should move where you want it, yet not be running all over or unable to press. Mix ratio can vary and it may have to be altered slightly depending on the weather conditions for your area. Use your eyes to see that the color looks correct, and your touch to determine the "feel" of the bead.
4. When dropping the bead on the nail, lift your brush for a brief moment and then gently press the bead. Continue pressing it from side to side to evenly distribute product.

Note: If the bead feels "sticky", the mix ratio is too wet.

Note: If working too wet, yellowing, lifting and "roll off" of the enhancement could result.

Zone 1 Smile Line and Extension

Using Attraction Radiant White, Attraction Soft White, Classic White, or Classic Titanium White Powders

1. Use the mix ratio method above previously mentioned.
2. Place a medium sized bead near the smile line in zone 1, and using the tip of the brush, gently press the smile line into place guiding and slightly pushing the products into the corner of the smile line. Keep the brush handle angled downward which will help to keep the smile line edge thicker and will also taper the extension edge.
3. Clean any excess product from your brush and roll into a point. To crisp and define the smile line, back brush while the product is still moveable.

Zone 2 and 3 using Attraction Radiant Pink, Attraction Purely Pink Masque, Attraction Purely Pink, Attraction Extreme Pink or Classic Purely Pink Powders

1. Use the mix ratio method previously mentioned.
2. Drop the bead just slightly beyond the smile line, without overlapping or touching the smile line.

3. Press gently from side to side to coat the nail evenly. Then very lightly, feather into the smile line. Be careful not to drag product over the white smile line. The intensity or opacity of the pink will cover or camouflage the white.
4. Continue into zone 3, leaving a tiny margin around the cuticle and sidewalls. This will assure that you are not overexposing your client.
5. If additional product is needed to create the apex, use a small bead of Totally Clear in zone 2.
6. After product application is complete, allow the nails to surface set for approximately one minute, until you hear a dull "click" when you tap on the enhancement.
7. The surface should feel slightly tacky.
8. Saturate an NSI Nail Wipe with Acetone.
9. Press the wipe to the nail and hold for approximately 30 seconds. This will eliminate "roll off".
10. Use a clean, unused NSI Nail Wipe saturated with NSI Cleanse for every 2 – 3 nails.
11. Proceed with Finishing.

Zone 1, 2, or 3, one color using Attraction Totally Clear, Attraction Sheer Pink, or Classic Pink, Classic Natural, or Classic Crystal Clear Powders

1. Use the mix ratio method above.
2. These powders are sheer or clear and can be used in all 3 zones. They can also be dragged over the smile line without camouflaging the whites.
3. After product application is complete, allow the nails to surface set for approximately one minute, until you hear a dull "click" when you tap on the enhancement.
4. The surface should feel slightly tacky.
5. Saturate an NSI Nail Wipe with Acetone.
6. Press the wipe to the nail and hold for approximately 30 seconds. This will eliminate "roll off".
7. Use a clean, unused NSI Nail Wipe saturated with NSI Cleanse for every 2 – 3 nails.
8. Proceed with Finishing.

Finishing

1. Using an NSI Black Cushion 180/240 Grit File, define the shape which is the outer edge, along the sidewalls and extension edge.
2. Refine surface and check for proper design and apex placement.
3. Remove excess dust with NSI Plush Brush.
4. Apply Glaze 'n Go or Perma Gloss following the directions on the packaging.
5. Condition surrounding skin with Nuture Oil.

Warning:
